RULES AND REGULATIONS

GREEN HILL CEMETERY is a non-profit corporation which will be forever maintained as an outstanding, beautiful resting place for our deceased.

All cemeteries are required, by State law, to provide perpetual care (e.g. mowing and trimming) of your lot. A portion of the cost of sales for your lot is set aside in a trust to provide for this.

Perpetual Care does not include general maintenance of monuments, markers, and vases.

Efficient workers, along with your cooperation, will help to keep the cemetery in good condition.

In order to keep costs to a minimum and maintain the cemetery in a professional manner, the Board of Directors deems the following regulations to be necessary.

1. NO TRESPASSING DUSK TO DAWN.

- 2. All burial decorations will be removed after 10 days. There are no restrictions for winter decorations from November 20th to March 15th. The board reserves the right to remove any material that they deem to be inappropriate.
- 3. Artificial and/or cut flowers may be placed at any time of the year on or within 12 inches of the main monument.
- 4. Planting and removal of flowers, shrubs, and trees, along with mulching must be pre-approved by the Superintendent.
- 5. Do not leave withered flowers on your lot. Large cans are provided at various places for such disposal.
- 6. The cemetery shall not be responsible for damage to sub-surface vases that have been installed by a monument dealer. The cemetery does all new installations.
- 7. The cemetery assumes no responsibility to bodily injury which may occur on cemetery grounds, or to any damage done by acts of God.
- 8. The cemetery is not responsible for any theft or vandalism to flowers, shrubbery, monuments, decorations or artifacts on lots.
- 9. All pets must remain in the vehicle.
- 10. The following are not permitted in the cemetery at any time.
 - Wire, rebar, or metal pins. (excluding Nov. 20th to March 15th)
 - · Glass or ceramic containers
 - Stone, lava stone, shredded tire mulch, or rubber mulch
 - Skateboards, scooters, inline skates and flying craft of any type.
 - · Drugs and alcohol
