

GREEN HILL CEMETERY ASSOCIATION

is a not-for-profit corporation chartered by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in 1873. State law requires the Association to reserve a percentage of the purchase price of each lot in this cemetery to provide for the perpetual care of that lot. Perpetual Care does not include maintenance of monuments, markers, vases, and other memorials. Visitors to Green Hill Cemetery, including lot-holders, are subject to the following Rules and Regulations:

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Cemetery grounds are open from dawn to dusk.
2. Littering on the grounds is prohibited. Trash receptacles are placed throughout the Cemetery.
3. Dogs shall be kept on leashes and remain on paved surfaces. Pet owners shall collect and remove from the premises all animal waste from their pets.
4. Skateboards, scooters, skates, and aircraft are prohibited on the Cemetery grounds.
5. Floral decorations may be placed only upon or within 12 inches of a monument. During the grass-mowing season (March 1 through November 15), the Association will remove all natural floral decorations after ten (10) days as well as any faded, wilted, damaged, or improperly placed decorations. The following are always prohibited in the Cemetery:
 - Rebar, metal pins, cans, crooks for hanging flags or other ornamentation, or wire (except from November 16 through February 29, when wire may be used to secure wreaths to monuments)
 - Glass or ceramic containers
 - Stone, lava stone, shredded tire, or rubber mulches.
6. Lot-holders shall not erect upon the Cemetery grounds any structure except granite, marble, or bronze memorials installed pursuant to cemetery guidelines. The Association reserves the right to remove any structure erected in violation of this rule without further notice to the lot-holder.
7. Floral tributes from funerals will be removed after ten (10) days.
8. The Association reserves the right to remove decorations it deems inappropriate.
9. Lot-holders shall obtain the Association's approval prior to planting, mulching, or removing flowers, shrubs, trees, and other planted vegetation.
10. The regulation of the erection of monuments and markers varies among the sections of the Cemetery. Lot-holders wishing to erect either a monument or markers or both should first consult the Association regarding what is permissible in a section.
11. The Association is not responsible for theft of or vandalism to flowers, shrubbery, memorials, vases, or other artifacts placed on lots in the Cemetery.
